GIVING BACK: BLANKET DRIVE:

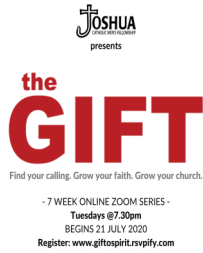
Many people are in need of blankets for the winter months. We will be collecting blankets over the next 2 weeks. Please help where you can. Please place in the box in the STM Church foyer.
