NEW PARISHIONERS WELCOME TEAM: Fr Stuart would like to get some parishioners to form a team to welcome new parishioners - this is separate to us improving our general welcome of visitors. Ideally new parishioners will get the message: **We can't wait to meet you!** In such a large parish as ours, we need to be purposeful in being personal. We want aspiring parishioners to know that **"It's important to us that you feel at home here."**

Parish membership will be a four-step process. The team will facilitate the following as described from the aspiring parishioners view and our response. Here goes:

1. **"I like this church!"** Complete the Communication Card.
2. **"But I don't know enough about it."** A member of our welcome team will call and arrange to meet with you.
3. **"Sign me up! I want to be a part of the team."** Attend a New Parishioner Welcome Event to fill out a formal registration card, these we be every two months—probably a wine & cheese welcome.
4. **"Do they remember me?"** Your Welcome Team member will check in with you periodically to see how you are doing.

CLEANING OF STM FOYER & COMPLEX: We have a contractor taking over the cleaning of the toilets and this will include the vacuuming of the Church foyer. Those rostered on as Church cleaners, please check if the foyer needs a vacuum—i.e. if it is obvious that it needs a vacuum, then please do so. If it looks Ok, you can leave it as the contractor will clean it when they come.

CHURCH CLEANERS: Please also vacuum the loft area. The key to the loft is in the fire box i.e. in the Chapel area on the wall outside the Priests Sacristy.

ALL USERS OF CHURCH COMPLEX: Please note that each group is responsible for cleaning the room they use, i.e. vacuuming after use. Also, if you use the kitchen, please use the dishwasher and PUT AWAY your dishes, wipe the benches and tidy up. Also, if you use the tablecloths, please take these home, wash, iron & return them promptly. Do not leave it to "someone else".

It feels a very appropriate day to include a quote from Oscar Romero's final homily, delivered just before he was assassinated while celebrating Mass.

"God's reign is already present on our earth in mystery. When the Lord comes, it will be brought to perfection. That is the hope that inspires Christians. We know that every effort to better society, especially when injustice and sin are so ingrained, is an effort that God blesses, that God wants, that God demands of us!"
