**SEA SUNDAY:** The men and woman on these ships can face treacherous sea conditions (both natural and depending on location - the threat of pirates is a reality), they are away from their families and friends for long periods of time, communications can be limited, their living quarters are small, there is not much 'personal space' as well as language can be a barrier.

We may not think too much how we end up with our fuel and goods we purchase, but 90% of these items are transported around the world on ships. In short, no seafarers = no trade.

Stella Maris is the Catholic Mission set up to support the United Seafarers Centre in Hull Road, Mt Maunganui which welcomes 12,000 seafarers each year. These seafarers comprise Filipino (60%+), Indian, Chinese and many other nationalities. We need more volunteers – especially those who can converse in the language of our visitors to provide a warm welcome. As well as financially supporting a welcoming Centre for seafarers to visit, Stella Maris provides Rosary Beads free of charge to Catholic seafarers, plus Bibles, beanies, etc. Your help in funding the above and/or volunteering would be greatly appreciated.
