Registrations of Interest are invited for an Establishment Board of Trustees for the possible establishment of a new Catholic Primary School that would be situated on the corner of Golden Sands Drive & The Boulevard in Papamoa, to be known as Suzanne Aubert Catholic School.

If established by the Minister of Education, Suzanne Aubert Catholic School (Papamoa) would be a Year 1-6 Primary school planned to open in Term 1, 2021. If the school is established, there will be five Ministerial appointments to an Establishment Board of Trustees governing the new school.

We are inviting Expressions of Interest from people with a balance of skills and experiences. An Establishment Board of Trustees is a Crown Entity. It is the employer of school staff, sets the school's overall direction and is future focused. See noticeboard for details. An Information Pack is available for anyone interested in considering this Invitation. This includes information for possible candidates on the criteria for appointment. The term for ministerial appointees to an Establishment Board varies. If established, we would expect the Establishment Board for Suzanne Aubert Catholic School to be in place for six to eight months before the school might open, and to stay in place up until the date that the Minister of Education sets for the election of an ongoing Board of Trustees. That is usually around six months after a school opens. **FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING, 24 November 2019**

**FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING:** Today is the last of the Church year, we celebrate as usual the Feast of Christ the King. It is one of the most beautiful and meaningful feasts of the year.

The concept of king and kingdom is at the very heart of Jesus' message to us. He came to inaugurate among us the Kingdom of God. By this we understand that those people and communities who have totally accepted and assimilated the vision of life under God which Jesus proclaimed. It is a vision not only for a minority sect among the peoples of the world but a call that is valid for all, a message which contains the deepest hopes and longings of peoples everywhere. Behind all this is the figure of Jesus Christ, our King. In himself he embodies the whole vision of the Kingdom by the way he lived, spoke, worked, taught, healed, liberated and finally sacrificed his life in love for us.

**APPLAUDING AT MASS:** Please see the comments from Pope Benedict & St Pope John XXIII below.

"Wherever applause breaks out in the liturgy because of some human achievement, it is a sure sign that the essence of liturgy has totally disappeared and been replaced by a kind of religious entertainment. Such attraction fades quickly – it cannot compete in the market of leisure pursuits, incorporating as it increasingly does various forms of religious titillation. (Pope Benedict)

Pope Saint John XXIII also said as people waited for him to arrive to a church outside of Rome, "I am very glad to have come here. But if I must express a wish, it is that in church you not shout out, that you not clap your hands, and that you not greet even the Pope, **because "The temple of God is the temple of God."**
