MASSES UNDER COVID LEVEL 2: Mass times: ALL MASSES are at St Thomas More Church—Sat Vigil 5pm; Sunday 9.30am & 5pm.

Come EARLY — AT LEAST 15 MINUTES BEFORE MASS is due to start—please do not come 5 minutes before Mass starts. Numbers are limited to 100 in total.

Doors open 1 hour before Mass times.

You must have a parish barcode.

Ignore the Mass times on your card. You can come to any of the 3 Masses—first in first served. Collect your barcode/s from the STM Church foyer on the table just inside the front doors. If we are full before you locate your card, then you will not be allowed in.

If you wish to wait outside practicing safe distancing and wearing masks if possible, we will endeavour to come out and distribute Communion. The Mass can be heard outside through speakers. If you require a barcode, please phone 07 575 4807 or email admin@allsaintsbythesea.nz & we will leave it on the table in the foyer for you to collect.

In the event of Level 3, there will be NO Masses.

RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION: Communion is only distributed in the hand, no chalices and **Communion will be distributed to you in your seat.**
