

CHURCH TO RENEW BISHOP POMPALLIER'S DEDICATION OF AOTEAROA NZ TO OUR LADY ASSUMED INTO HEAVEN:

All the Bishops will gather in Wellington on **Sun, 15 August** – the Feast of the Assumption -- for a Mass to renew Bishop Pompallier's 1838 dedication of Aotearoa New Zealand to Our Lady Assumed into Heaven. The Mass will be celebrated at St Mary of the Angels Church, which will become a national shrine to Mary of the Assumption.

The Bishops have commissioned an icon artwork of Mary by Christchurch artist Damien Walker which will be taken on a hiko around the six dioceses in the three months before August 15.
