ST PATRICK'S CHURCH, TE PUKE:

At times we are faced with situations that are difficult to handle as no matter what decision is made some will be unhappy and even hurt. This has been the situation this week when the IEA (Initial Earthquake Report) on St Patrick's Church Te Puke was received.

The report shows that the building has only 15% of strength of the current building code. Territorial authorities and the practice of Dioceses is that under 25% strength requires immediate action. Accordingly the Parish Finance Committee has determined that the church will be closed immediately. The Church will not re-open until decisions are made regarding strengthening or other options. Further analysis is being done by our consultants Beca and we will have further information late March regarding the options for strengthening and cost bands.

Sunday Mass will continue as normal in Te Puke, only the venue will change. The new venue will be St John the Baptist Anglican Church, Jocelyn St, Te Puke. During the week can only get the use of the church on a Thursday morning. As a result a Mass will be held at 9am on a Thursday and there will be no further Tuesday liturgies. The primary venue for funerals will be St Thomas More Church. Fr Stuart Young
