Word of God Sunday

This Sunday we celebrate Word of God Sunday, an opportunity to reflect on the Word of God and to renew our commitment to read and pray with Scripture each day. Pope Benedict XVI said, “If all Catholics read the Scriptures, there would be a new springtime in the Church.” As well as the Bible and the weekday and Sunday Missals, there are also apps that can help us read the daily readings, such as Universalis, which also provides the Prayer of the Church and a short commentary on the Saint of the Day.

We do not need to read a large amount of Scripture. Even one to twelve verses are enough. The key is to read slowly, pausing at the end of each verse. This is prayer and is a simple and meaningful way of praying with the Scriptures.
