This weekend we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday which focuses on prayer for vocations to the Priesthood. We do need to wonder why we have few vocations now in New Zealand. Men are no longer lining up to go to the seminary and I wonder why? Have we become so secular, (worldly) that giving one's life in a Priestly vocation is no longer an attractive option. When I was in the seminary there were eight students for Hamilton Diocese and 6 were ordained and one became a Bishop. Let us pray for our two seminarians, Nhat Long Cao and Hung Van Ha.

As we continue to pray for an increase of Priestly vocations for our diocese and at the same time let us foster vocations within the family and encourage men to consider this vocation (plant the seed). Creating an awareness of all vocations should be an important part of the life of all Christians. Essentially vocations come from the family.
