He was always willing to help out celebrating the occasional Mass, hearing confessions during Lent and Advent, and assisting with the children's confessions and their families in the Sacramental Programme.

This year he helped with all the Easter ceremonies at St Thomas More. Most Tuesday mornings after Mass, he would join me at the Presbytery for eggs on toast.

In addition to regularly attending Mass at St Thomas More, he was often present at St Patrick's in Te Puke and Suzanne Aubert. In his quiet and humble way, he made a real impact on the parish.

Fr Joe was a deeply loved priest of the Diocese of Hamilton and will be missed by many.

May he rest in peace and see God face to face, good and faithful servant.
