This week we begin Holy Week with Palm Sunday (also known as Passion Sunday). It is the most sacred and significant week in the Church's liturgical calendar, culminating in the Easter Triduum – Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil. We journey with Jesus from His entry into Jerusalem on a donkey, hailed as King, to His gift of the Last Supper – the first Mass. Then we walk with Him through His saving death and finally rejoice in His glorious Resurrection. This is a precious time for us to reflect on the depth of God's love for us – a love shown through the sacrifice of His Son for our salvation.

HOLY PLACES COLLECTION ON GOOD FRIDAY: Our NZ Bishops, along with all the bishops around the world, were recently sent a letter from Cardinal Claudio Gugerotti appealing for the promotion of the Good Friday Collection. Every year, the faithful contribute money to support Christians in the Holy Land and the Church's mission to care for the places linked to Jesus' earthly life. Christians residing in the Holy Land require the concrete assistance of the universal Church.

The Cardinal acknowledged the tears, despair and destruction we have witnessed, but reminded us our *hope* is that the defeat inflicted by death will not be its eternal victory. That our *hope* is renewed in the Resurrection of our Lord, who in that very land revealed the wounds of His passion, alive.
